

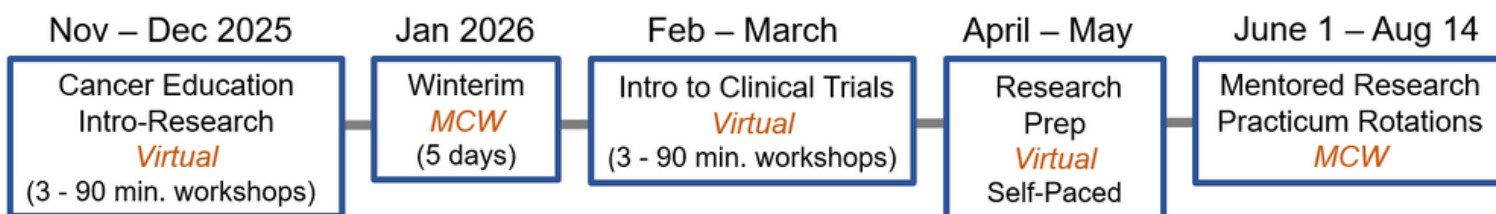


Launch Your Career in Cancer Research with SPARCC, Apply Now!
